


Statistics:


- Just over one in three Garrett County high school youth drank alcohol in the past 30 days.
- One in five reported binge drinking in the past 30 days (5 or more drinks in a row on one occasion).
- Garrett County's underage drinking trends show a steady decline for the last 15 years.
- Most Garrett County youth (77.3%) believe their parents would disapprove if they used alcohol regularly. (Garrett County Core Measure Survey, 2017)

Core Messages:

- Alcohol is the most commonly used and abused drug among youth in the United States.
- More than 90% of alcohol consumed by youth is consumed in the form of binge drinking.
- Youth report that the most common source for alcohol is from social sources such as friends, relatives, or other adults.
